My Journey as an Multi-Disciplinary Scholar: Bouncing from Tourism to Education to Geography in Research, Teaching, and Service



Dr. Pat Maher is the Dean of Teaching and a Full Professor in Physical and Health Education at Nipissing University. He has previously held appointments at Cape Breton University, the University of Northern British Columbia, and the University of Otago. Pat is a 3M National Teaching Fellow and a Fellow of the Royal Canadian Geographical Society. He held a Commonwealth Scholarship for his doctoral work, and while at CBU was both a University Teaching Chair in Community Engaged Teaching and Scholarship and a SSHRC Exchange University Research Chair in the Social Sciences and Humanities.

Pat is Chair of the International Polar Tourism Research Network and the lead for the University of the Arctic - Thematic Network on Northern Tourism. He is a member of the Steering Committee for the International Outdoor Education Research Conference, as well as the Canadian Outdoor Summit. Pat is editor of the Canadian Journal of Environmental Education, former editor (and current Associate Editor) of the Journal of Experiential Education, and Associate Editor of the Canadian Journal for the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning. He also sits on the International Advisory Board of the Journal of Adventure Education and Outdoor Learning and the Editorial Board of the Journal of Tourism Futures and Pathways: The Ontario Journals of Outdoor Education.
